



Mayfield Soccer Club Scholarship

Mayfield Soccer club will be awarding two \$500 scholarships to a male and female soccer player from Mayfield High School.

Amount of Scholarship

The amount of the scholarship will be \$500.00 for one male recipient and \$500.00 for one female recipient. The scholarship will be issued one time for each recipient and will be non-renewable.

Scholarship Committee

The Scholarship Committee shall consist of five (5) members consisting of the Club President, Club Vice President, Club Treasurer, Club Field Marshall and Club Advisor. A committee member may not have a relative applying for the Mayfield Soccer Club Scholarship. The Club President will elect a replacement committee member if such conflicts arise.

Selection Process

The Club President will receive the scholarship applications first. Copies will then be given to the committee so the name of the student is unavailable. The committee will rate the application according to the following criteria without knowing the name of the student involved.

1. Soccer involvement – Scale points 1-8
2. Academic Standing – Scale points 1-8
3. Teacher (2) evaluations – Scale points 1-5
4. Extracurricular activities – Scale points 1-4
5. Community service/Volunteer programs – Scale points 1-5
6. Essay – Scale points 1-20

A maximum point scale of 50 can be achieved. The student with the highest point scale will be selected.

If the Club President is related to a qualifying senior applicant, his duties will be performed by the Club Vice President, followed by the Treasurer.

Eligibility

Mayfield High School Graduating seniors who have actively participated in the Mayfield Soccer Club for at least three (3) years seasons, and who will be attending a university, college or trade school in the year after graduation.



Criteria for Consideration

1. Must have demonstrated a strong history of soccer involvement.
2. Academic standing.
3. Teacher (2) evaluations.
4. Extracurricular activities.
5. Participation in community service and/or volunteer programs.
6. Essay: Submit a brief narrative of no more than 1,000 words describing how soccer has affected or influenced your life.

Instructions for completing and submitting application

1. Complete entire scholarship application form
2. Teacher evaluation forms – must be completed by two separate teachers
3. Scholastic report – must be completed by a high school counselor
4. Completed applications must be submitted to the Club President or mailed with a postmark no later than April 15th of the current year. Completed applications may be mailed to:

Final Selection

1. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications submitted in accordance with the scholarship guidelines.
2. The selected students will be notified in writing as soon as possible and announcement of the selections will be made in June.
3. Scholarship funds will be issued to the selected applicants upon the submittal of an acceptance letter from an accredited college, university or trade school.
