## **Rules of the MSC Recreation League**

1. All participants must wear shin guards or they will not be permitted to play.
2. Players should not wear jewelry during the game and may be asked to remove it before taking the field.
3. No parent, coach or spectator is permitted behind the goal area for any reason during the game.
4. Parents and spectators must sit on the opposite sideline from the player's bench.
5. Snacks are a great thing after the game, but please be respectful of the school or park grounds and pick up any trash before leaving a site... this includes water bottles... sidelines far too many times are left littered with trash.
6. The referee's decision is FINAL!! There will be absolutely NO arguing of any call. Confrontation with a referee will mean automatic ejection from the field.
7. We are always looking for volunteers. So please do not offer criticism to someone who has donated their time to help the children... Please offer help!
